
Dear Attorney General Caldwell:

Attached is a copy of a certified letter to you dated November 21, 2008. No reply has been received. Pertaining to that letter, Mr. Dan S. Collins and I did not actually meet with you on March 19, 2008. We met with you on March 26, 2008. On March 19, 2008, while we met with Senator "Nick" Gautreaux, he telephoned you about viewing the information being presented to him that day. The March 26, 2008 meeting with you occurred as a result of that meeting with him and as a result of his recommendation. Due to your continued silence, to my knowledge and in my opinion, there are timely and substantive material issues at Bayou Postillion not being fully addressed by you and/or your office (such as the purported servitude agreement, boundary agreement, past mineral leasing activities, etc.).

The Louisiana Constitution mandates that you first protect the rights of the individual and the good of the whole. I know of no evidence that you and/or your office intends to fully address all of the material issues at Bayou Postillion for the good of the public.

Should there now exist (and/or ever have existed) any personal and/or official relationship(s) that you determine hinder you and/or your office from fulfilling its constitutional mandate, as an individual taxpayer and citizen of the State of Louisiana, I hereby strongly urge that you immediately comply with at least the Rules of Professional Conduct (including but not limited to Article XVI) of the Louisiana State Bar Association and (consistent with the intent of your constitutional powers and duties) immediately convey all Bayou Postillion matters to a party and/or parties that will fully protect the constitutionally declared rights of the individual and the good of the whole.


Dear Attorney General Caldwell:

On March 19, 2008, Mr. Dan S. Collins and I met with you about certain events connected to the Bayou Postillion Water Quality Project. Mr. Collins left many documents and a large amount of information with you at that time. You told us that you would reply after you and/or your office had a chance to review what he supplied. To-date (eight months later), neither Mr. Collins nor I have heard anything at all from you.

As you know, in August of 2008 there commenced a federal litigation related to the Bayou Postillion Water Quality Project. That litigation is directly related to some of the facts and information supplied to you in the March meeting. Since your office is now defending the State in that litigation, I understand if there may now be some reluctance to speak to us about the project. Please be advised, in my opinion, there are material issues (not before the court in that complaint) that can be discussed and acted upon by your office and/or others to the immediate benefit of the citizens of the State of Louisiana.

Mr. Collins and I welcome discussions with you and/or your personnel about Bayou Postillion on matters outside the environmental allegations presently before the federal court.
